Placement Testing

When you arrive at Humber, your English skills will be assessed (grammar, reading, writing, and speaking) to determine your appropriate level of study in the program. Detailed testing information will be mailed to you once you have been accepted into EAP.

You will also learn about exciting activities offered through our International Student Services such as Pizza and Movie Nights, trips to Niagara Falls and the CN Tower, hockey and basketball games, and much more.
